Amendments agreed May 2018 as follows:

9. MARKS

~~9.4 The dolphin will be a large orange inflatable buoy.~~

9.4 Mark J will ~~only~~ be used for junior races or may be used for other races if no juniors racing

10. AREAS THAT ARE OBSTRUCTIONS

10.1 A large inflatable orange buoy, referred to as the Dolphin, placed in the vicinity of the northern shore at the entrance to Neatishead Cut, denotes a shallow water area. It shall be treated as an obstruction and shall be passed to the east. RRS19 (Room to Pass an Obstruction) shall apply, excluding 19.2(a). RRS 18 (Mark Room) shall not apply.

13. THE FINISH

13.2 After finishing, a boat is still racing until her hull, crew and all equipment, in their normal positions, have crossed the finish line.

Amendments agreed June 2018 as follows:

4. HANDICAP RACES

~~4.1 For purposes of handicap races, Allcomers A is defined as for centreboard dinghies excluding boats with a handicap 1250 and over, and Allcomers B as for keel boats including the Yarmouth and the Kinsman.~~
